J.N.Pandey, for the State.</p> <p>By this order we are going to dispose off the bail application filed on behalf of the accused/ petitioners, namely 1. Suleman Safi and 2. Anita Devi, who are in judicial custody since 27.01.2026 in connection with Pipra PS Case No.:– 09/26, u/s- 137(2), 140(3) of B.N.S.</p> <p>Ld. counsel for the accused/ petitioners argued that accused/ petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no crime and they have falsely been implicated in this case due to local politics and enmity. He further submitted that accused/ petitioners are not involved in any other case and having the clean antecedent. He further submitted that the offence as alleged in FIR is not applicable against the accused/ petitioners. It is also submitted that both the accused/ petitioners are in judicial custody since 27.01.2026 and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/ petitioners behind the bar.</p> <p>Ld. PP for the State strongly opposed the prayer of bail application.</p> <p>In brief, the prosecution story is that on dated 08.01.2026 the minor daughter of the informant, aged about 13 years was missing from her house. When the informant enquired from his family members, it was came to his knowledge that 2-3 accused persons came there on motorcycle and searching his daughter. It was also came to his knowledge that the accused persons namely Subhan Safi, Satish Kumar, Subhash Kumar, Suleman Safi, Raunak Kumari and other unknown persons have kidnapped his daughter on a motorcycle for the purpose of human trafficking. Thereafter, the informant has gone to the house of the above named accused persons but they were also missing from their respective house. The informant further alleged that the accused Subhan Safi and Subhash Kumar earlier also gone to the judicial custody for human trafficking. The informant expressed apprehension that these accused persons have kidnapped his minor daughter for the purpose of human trafficking.</p> <p>Argument heard from both sides and perused the record as well as case diary. Admittedly, both the accused/ petitioners are in judicial custody since 27.01.2026. On going through the case diary, it transpires that the police also recorded the statement of the witnesses namely Om Prakash Mandal, Vijay Kumar and Indubhushan Kumar and they</p>	<p>Contd.</p>

have duly supported the prosecution case. The police also collected the call details of the mobile numbers as stated by the I.O in para No.17 of the case diary. As per para No.23 of the case diary, the date of birth of the victim girl is 22.12.2008. The offence was committed on 08.01.2026. Hence, on the date of commission of the crime she was aged about 17 years 16 days. The police also recorded the statement of the victim girl u/s- 180 of BNSS and the victim girl categorically stated that she has gone to Delhi at the house of Md. Suleman Safi, who is the father of accused Subhan Safi and remained there several days and recovered by the Delhi Police and brought to Pipra Police Station. The statement of the victim girl was also recorded u/s- 183 of BNSS and the victim girl was handed over to her parents. The main accused Subhan Safi has declared juvenile and he was also produced before the JJB, Supaul. On minute scrutiny of the entire case diary as well as other materials, it transpires that the minor girl was gone to Delhi with accused Subhan Safi and these two accused/petitioners, who are the parents of accused Subhan Safi have kept the minor girl inside the house and the minor girl was recovered by the Delhi Police and brought to Pipra Police Station. There is the rampant cases of human trafficking in border area. The accused/petitioners, who are the parents of the main accused Subhan Safi, have assisted the offence by concealing the victim girl inside their house. The allegation against the accused/petitioners are very serious in nature. The investigation of this case is in primary stage. There is strong apprehension of tempering of the prosecution evidence by the accused/petitioners.

Hence, taking into consideration the seriousness of the allegation, I find that both the accused/ petitioners are not entitled to be enlarged on bail. Therefore, the bail application, filed on behalf of both accused/petitioners, namely 1. Suleman Safi and 2. Anita Devi stands, **Rejected. However, accused/ petitioners are at liberty to file the fresh bail application after filling of the charge-sheet.**
