J.N.Pandey, for the State.</p> <p>By this order we are going to dispose off the bail application filed on behalf of the accused/ petitioner, namely Pramod Yadav @ Pramod Kumar Yadav, who is in judicial custody since 26.01.2026 in connection with Nirmali PS case No.214/25, u/s- 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 307, 352, 351(2) of B.N.S.</p> <p>Ld. counsel for the accused/ petitioner submitted that accused/ petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no crime and he has falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. He further submitted that accused/ petitioner is also involved in 4 other criminal cases. He further submitted that the offence as alleged in FIR is not applicable against the accused/ petitioner. It is also submitted that accused/ petitioner is in judicial custody since 26.01.2026 and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/ petitioner behind the bar.</p> <p>Ld. PP for the State strongly opposed the prayer of bail application.</p> <p>In brief, the prosecution story is that on dated 04.12.2025 at about 01:00 P.M., 5 accused persons named in FIR including this accused/ petitioner along with 5 other unknown persons caught hold the son of the informant and put the <i>Gamcha</i> around his neck and tried to snatch the mobile phone and cash from him. Accused Bhawesh Kumar Yadav also snatched the key of motorbike and accused Ramvilash Yadav also snatched cash of Rs.25,000/- from his pocket and all the accused persons also assaulted him by kick and fist and by the leather belt. The accused persons also threatened the son of the informant not to disclose this fact to anyone. Thereafter, the informant came at his house and informed his parent about the incident. Thereafter, the informant and her husband came at the house of the accused Lakshman Yadav then the accused person also abused the informant and snatched her <i>Mangalsutra</i>. Accused Lakshman Yadav also assaulted the informant on her leg by iron-rod.</p> <p>Argument heard from both sides and perused the record as well as case diary. Admittedly, this accused/ petitioner is in judicial custody since 26.01.2026. On perusal of the case diary, it appears that the police has also recorded the statement of the witness</p>

namely Indrajit Kumar. As per para No.31 of the case diary, this accused/ petitioner is also involved in 4 other criminal cases. The police has also collected the non-bailable warrant against the accused persons namely Praduman Kumar, Ramvilash Yadav, Bhawesh Yadav and Lakshman Yadav. Even after withholding the salary of the I.O, injury report has not been furnished by him. The I.O has nowhere stated in the case diary whether any stolen article was recovered by the police or not.

Hence, keeping in mind the period of custody and other surrounding circumstances, I find that accused/ petitioner is entitled to be enlarged on bail. Therefore, the bail application, filed on behalf of accused/ petitioner, namely Pramod Yadav @ Pramod Kumar Yadav stands **Allowed** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below and one of the bailor must be family member or close relative.
