07.04.2026	<p>The present Anticipatory Bail Application has been filed by the applicant-accused Kishore Kumar Chaudhary who have apprehension of arrest in a case Pipra P. S. Case No. 58/2026 registered under section 30(a) Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.</p> <p>Ld. Counsel for defence has pressed the bail petition and submitted that the applicant-accused is innocent and has committed no offence. The applicant-accused has not filed any bail application in any court apart from this court. There is one criminal antecedent against the applicant-accused. The instant case is totally false. The applicant-accused is not indulged in liquor business. It is, therefore, prayed by Ld. Counsel for defence to release the applicant accused on bail.</p> <p>Ld. Spl. P.P has vehemently opposed the bail petition and prayed to reject the bail petition.</p> <p>The prosecution story in brief is that the informant Rageeb Hasan S.I., proceeded on Day-patrolling on 16.02.2026, along with police forces. Kishore Kumar Chaudhary was carrying liquor in a Car towards Chhatapur via Champanagar, Dubiyahi to Maheshpur. After informing the senior officials, for verification of the information received, he cordoned off a deserted place about 100 meters ahead of Dubiyahi Haat and started checking the vehicles passing by. During vehicle checking, at 08:00 O' clock, he saw a Black coloured Car coming from the side of Champanagar. He directed the driver to stop the vehicle. The driver and the another person stopped the vehicle, got down and started running. An attempt was made to catch them, but they managed to escape by taking the advantage of crop grown in the adjacent field. Some persons gathered there who were requested to be an independent search witness to which they denied. After that Constable - 429 Chandan Kumar and Constable - 1091 Rakesh Kumar of the raiding party, were made seizure-list witnesses. After giving his Jama-Talashi and his team, they started searching Verna SX Car bearing Reg. No. WB06H8285. During search, 1620 bottles of Nepali Dilwale Sophie, 300 ml each, contained in 54 cartoons, total 486 litre liquor was recovered from the back seat and dicky of the car. Thereafter, the Car and recovered liquor were seized and a seizure-list was prepared before both the independent witnesses who voluntarily made their signature on it. On enquiry, local people revealed the name of the escaped person as Kishore Kumar Chaudhary.

Heard both the parties and carefully perused the case record. On perusal it transpires that the applicant-accused is named in the FIR, who fled away from the place of occurrence on seeing the police forces. According to the FIR there is an allegation of transportation of 486 litre Nepali Dilwale Sophie liquor by the applicant-accused by the

Car bearing Reg. No. WB06H8285. In para 3, 4, 5, the witnesses have supported the prosecution case and recovery of liquor. Therefore, the provisions of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act 2016 are attracted against the applicant-accused. The case is still under investigation.

In these facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to give privilege of anticipatory bail to the applicant-accused. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application of the applicant-accused **Kishore Kumar Chaudhary** is hereby **rejected**.
