

In the Court of Sessions Judge, Supaul
Cri. Misc. Case No.-19/2026

09.06.2026:-

The instant criminal misc. petition is filed by the Ld. counsel for the accused/petitioner namely, Mukesh Kumar @ Mukesh Paswan, for extension of the period for filing the bail bond before the Lower Court.

Argument heard from both the sides and perused the order dated 22.11.2023 passed in ABA No.-1523/2023.

In this case, the anticipatory bail application of accused/petitioner was allowed by this Court on 22.11.2023 in ABA No.-1523/2023 and accused/petitioner was directed to furnish his bail bonds within 15 days from passing of the order.

Ld. counsel for the accused/petitioner submitted that the accused/petitioner could not appear in the court within stipulated time and the reason for such delay that the accused/petitioner was staying outside of the village for earning his livelihood and due to which he could not file his bail bond in the light of order passed by the Principal District & Sessions Judge Court, Supaul within stipulated period and non-filing of the bail bond before the lower court was neither intentional but was due to the above said reason.

The Ld. P.P. opposed the prayer made on behalf of Ld. counsel for petitioner and submits that he deliberately did not furnish his bail bond within stipulated time and, hence, the instant Criminal Misc. Petition be ordered to be rejected.

Considering the submission made on behalf of both the sides and taking into consideration, accused/petitioner is allowed to furnish his bail bond within 10 days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this order, as a fine of Rs.500/- has already been deposited in D.L.S.A, Supaul by the accused/petitioner vide receipt no.-121, dated-09-06-2026 and same is being kept on the record. Other terms and conditions shall remain the same as mentioned in earlier bail order dated 22.11.2023 passed in ABA No.-1523/2023 are intact. O/C is directed to send the copy of this order to concerned below at once.

Accordingly, instant criminal misc. petition is hereby disposed off.
