

Jasvir Singh @ Jassa Vs State of Punjab. BA/678/2026

Bail application under Section 483 BNS.

ORDER

Heard on the 3rd bail application, filed by applicant-accused **Jasvir Singh @ Jassa** for the grant of regular bail, in FIR No.270 dated 10.09.2020 under Sections 15, 18, 25 NDPS Act, Police Station Sirhind.

2. Report of Ahlmad has been received, who has reported that **earlier bail applications filed by the applicant/accused have been decided.**

3. It has been argued by learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant has been falsely implicated by the police of Police Station Sirhind. Applicant is an innocent person having no criminal background. The applicant is a peace loving and law abiding citizen and has no concern or connection with the commission of alleged offence. Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court granted regular bail to the applicant and thereafter, he was declared proclaimed offender on 13.01.2025. Now he has been arrested and is in custody since 13.05.2026. He is no more required by the police for any purpose. Hence, prayer has been made for release of the applicant on bail.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl. PP for the State has contended that earlier the applicant was granted bail in this case and

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thereafter, he absconded and was declared proclaimed offender. Therefore, he is not entitled to concession of bail. Hence, he has prayed for dismissal of the same.

5. FIR has been registered against the applicant/accused as there was recovery of 200 Kg. of poppy husk and 150 grams opium from the truck which was being driven by Jasvir Singh @ Jassa applicant/accused accompanied by his co-accused. He was granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court on 30.11.2021. Thereafter, he absented himself on 30.08.2024 and was declared as proclaimed offender on 13.01.2025. Thereafter, he was apprehended and is in custody since 13.05.2026. The trial remained hampered due to his long absence. In these circumstances, there is every apprehension that on release on bail, he may abscond and again trial will remain hamper and hence, he is not entitled to the concession of regular bail at this stage. Bail application stands dismissed accordingly. Copy of the bail order be sent to the accused to be served through Jail Superintendent. File be attached with main file, if any pending, otherwise be consigned to the record room.
