<u>15/06/2026</u>	Ram Ratan Roy, S/o- Sahdeo Roy, R/o- Piprahi, Ward No.01, PS- Ratanpura, District- Supaul;Accused/Petitioner Vs. State of Bihar.O.P. Ld. Counsel for petitioner Sri. Shiv Bhushan Singh, Advocate. Ld. APP Md. Abu Jaffar, for the State. By this order we are going to dispose off the anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of accused/ petitioner, namely Ram Ratan Roy, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Ratanpura PS Case No.:-99/2025, u/s- 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109, 132, 121, 122, 262, 263,352, 351(2), 351(3) of B.N.S. Ld. counsel for the accused/ petitioner argued that accused/ petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no crime and he has falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics and enmity. He further submitted that accused/ petitioner is also involved in 6 more criminal cases. He further submitted that the offence as alleged in FIR is not applicable against the accused/ petitioner. It is also submitted that accused/ petitioner is ready to abide by the provisions of section 482 of B.N.S.S, so he may be admitted to the anticipatory bail. Ld. APP for the State strongly opposed the anticipatory bail application. In brief, the prosecution story is that on dated 20.12.2025, a police team lead by Sub-Inspector, Raju Kumar reached at village Piprahi, Ward No.01 at the house of Ramratan Roy at about 02:15 A.M., for the investigation of a case bearing Ratanpura PS Case No.88/25 of Bihar Excise Act and the police team overpowered Ramratan Roy and in the meantime 8 accused persons named in FIR came there and forcibly tried to take away the accused Ramratan Roy and also assaulted the police party by stick and iron-rod, thereby Sub-Inspector, Raju Kumar sustained injury on his nose and accused Ramratan Roy managed to run away from the place of occurrence. However, his brother Raushan Kumar Roy was overpowered by the police party. Argument heard from both sides and perused the record as well as case diary. On going through the case diary, it transpires that the members of the raiding party namely Sub-Inspector, Ajit Kumar Pandey, Sub-Inspector, Sumit Kumar Singh and constable Swarnabh Sanu have duly supported the prosecution case. Admittedly, the police team has arrived at the place of occurrence to arrest	Contd.
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<u>Contd.</u> <u>15/06/2026</u>	this accused/ petitioner in Ratanpura PS Case No.88/25. As per para No.3 of his anticipatory bail application, this accused/ petitioner is also involved in 6 other criminal cases of serious nature such as (i) Ratanpura PS Case No.368/24, (ii) Ratanpura PS Case No.56/21, (iii) Ratanpura PS Case No.29/21, (iv) Ratanpura PS Case No.44/25, (v) Ratanpura PS Case No.58/21 and (vi) Ratanpura PS case No.88/25. On going through the case diary, it transpires that this accused/ petitioner is the habitual offender. Ld. counsel for the accused/ petitioner is also submitted the photocopy of anticipatory bail order passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna, arising out of Ratanpura PS Case No.88/25, but the same was granted after the registration of this FIR. Hence, the accused/ petitioner cannot get the benefit of said order. The allegation against this accused/ petitioner is very serious in nature and he is also involved in 6 other criminal cases of serious nature. The investigation of this is in primary stage. The custodial interrogation of accused/ petitioner is also required. The tempering of the prosecution evidence also cannot be ruled out. Hence, keeping in mind the seriousness of allegation and the previous involvement of the accused/ petitioner, I find that accused/ petitioner is not entitled to get the benefit of anticipatory bail. As such, the prayer of the anticipatory bail, on behalf of accused/ petitioner namely Ram Ratan Roy is hereby, Rejected. Dictated -Sd- (Anant Singh) Sessions Judge, Supaul	
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
