<u>14/08/26</u>	Ld. Counsel for petitioner Sri. Shankar Kumar Singh and Sri. Shiv Bhushan Singh, Advocates. Ld. APP Sri. Rajesh Kumar Singh, for the State. By this order this court is going to dispose off the bail application filed on behalf of accused/ petitioner, namely Rajesh Paswan, who is in judicial custody since 06.06.2026 in connection with Pipra PS case No.386/23, u/s- 147, 149, 341, 342, 323, 354(B), 307, 379 of IPC. Ld. counsel for the accused/ petitioner submitted that accused/ petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no crime and he has falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. He further submitted that accused/ petitioner is also involved in three more cases. He further submitted that the offence as alleged in FIR is not applicable against the accused/ petitioner. He further submitted that there is land dispute between both the parties and the instant case is counter-blast of Pipra PS Case No.388/23. It is also submitted that the accused/ petitioner is in judicial custody since 06.06.2026 and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/ petitioner behind the bar. Ld. APP for the State strongly opposed the prayer of bail application. In brief, the prosecution story is that on dated 16.12.2023 at about 12:00 noon, 13 accused persons including this accused/ petitioner having the deadly weapon were forcibly ploughing the agricultural field of the informant. When the informant and her family members objected then accused Shivdatta Paswan exhorted the other accused persons and petitioner Shivdatta Paswan having the <i>farsa</i> in his hand assaulted the husband of informant on his head thereby he sustained injury and fell down on the ground. Accused Rajesh Paswan also assaulted Mithlesh Paswan on his head, accused Ajay Paswan assaulted Karan, accused Shambhu Paswan assaulted Sikendra Paswan. Accused persons also snatched the gold chain of the informant and torn her clothes and also demanded the <i>Rangadari</i> from the informant. Argument heard from both sides and perused the lower court record. Admittedly there is land dispute between both the parties and a counter-case was also filed by one of the accused namely Shivdatta Paswan against the informant and his family members	Contd.

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bearing Pipra PS Case No.388/23. As per FIR there is allegation against this accused/ petitioner for causing injury to the injured Mithlesh Paswan on his head, but the docotor has opined the nature of injury as simple. As per submission of Ld. counsel, this accused/ petitioner is also involved in 3 other cases. It is pertinent to mention here that the other co-accused namely Shivdatta Paswan has got the regular bail by this court vide order dated 10.05.2024 in BA No.256/24. The accused/ petitioner is in judicial custody since 06.06.2026 and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/ petitioner behind the bar.

Hence keeping in mind the period of custody as well as nature of injury, I find that the accused/ petitioner is inclined to be enlarged on bail. Therefore, the bail application, filed on behalf of accused/ petitioner, namely Rajesh Paswan stands **Allowed** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below.
