The present complaint has been filed by Rajeev Kumar Mehta (complainant) against the proposed accused persons namely (1) Ramphal Mehta (2) Shambu Mehta (3) Shivphal Mehta (4) Resham Lal Mehta (5) Phul Kumari Devi and (6) Savitri Kumari. The court will assess the material on record to decide that if there are sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused persons. <u>Evidence adduced during the Inquiry:</u> During the inquiry, the complainant Rajeev Kumar Mehta did not appear for the recording of SA and no Inquiry witness was examined. The Complainant has not filed any documentary evidence with the complaint. The complainant has been continuously absent since the inception of the complaint and has after giving ample opportunities of 12 dates to appear for the recording of SA, his inquiry evidence is hereby closed. <u>Discussion of the Evidence:</u> Perused the complaint petition. After reading the entire complaint petition, I find that there are no sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused persons named above.
