ORDER

1. Ld. Counsel for the revisionists submits that present criminal revision has been filed assailing the impugned order dated 12.12.2025 wherein while passing the order under section 163 of BNSS, learned S.D.M, Siwan has opined on the title as well as possession over the disputed land, which does not fall within the jurisdiction of learned S.D.M, Siwan in exercise of his power under section 163 of BNSS.
2. Ld. P.P opposes prayer of the revisionist.
3. From perusal of certified copy of the impugned order filed with this revision petition, this court finds that the learned S.D.M, Siwan erroneously opined on the claim and title of the parties over the disputed land and therefore, he has gone beyond his jurisdiction under section 163 of BNSS. The impugned order passed by the learned S.D.M, Siwan also does not talk about any imminent nuisance or apprehended danger.
4. In view of the above, the impugned order dated 12.12.2025 passed by the learned S.D.M, Siwan in M. No. 3243/2025 is hereby set aside.
5. Accordingly, present revision petition is disposed of as **allowed**.
6. Office is directed to consign record of this case to the record room after necessary compliance.
