ORDER

18.03.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Harendra Ram, (2) Ravish Kumar**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Siwan Muffasil P.S Case No. 32/2026 registered u/s 115(2), 126(2), 351(2), 352, 92 of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. The allegation levelled against these petitioners is totally false, baseless and concocted. There is counter case too. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the case record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR Vide- Siwan Muffasil P.S Case No. 32/2026 was registered on 20.01.2026 u/s 115(2), 126(2), 351(2), 352, 92 of BNS against the petitioners along with other co-accused persons. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that on 18.01.2026 at about 12:00 o'clock, Puja Devi was washing cloth and she was throwing water on the Darwaja of informant. When the informant protested, Puja Devi started hurling abuses and catching her hair. It is alleged that Ravish Kumar assaulted on the abdomen of informant with leg and fat and slaps. When the informant's husband came to her rescue, Ravish Kumar also assaulted him. Harendra Ram, Suganti Devi, Manju Devi, Rima Devi, threatened to kill the informant.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is specific allegation against the petitioner Ravish Kumar that he assaulted on the abdomen of informant with leg and fat and slaps, as the result, she sustained following injury:-

(1) Pain abdomen bleeding p/v pregnancy 3 months Gynac opinion USG whole abdomen and doctor kept the opinion reserved of the said injury. Thus, injury is intandam with the allegation.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-18 of photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and specific allegation, the present anticipatory bail application qua petitioner **Ravish Kumar** is hereby **rejected**.

9. So far as, the bail petition of petitioner **Harendra Ram**, is concerned, there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner.

10. Considering the aforesaid facts and the fact that there is omnibus allegation against the petitioner **Harendra Ram**, the present anticipatory bail petition of petitioner **Harendra Ram** is **allowed**.

11. It is directed that in the event of his arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioner shall be released on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
