ORDER

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **Bijendra Mahto @ Bijendra Chauhan**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No. 296/2022 registered u/s 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 435, 427, 504, 506/34 of IPC.
2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Other similarly co-accused persons have been granted bail by Ld. predecessor of this court vide A.B.P No. 928/2024. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.
4. Heard. Perused the record.
5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Bhagwanpur Hat P.S. Case No. 296/2022 was registered on 19.11.2022 u/s 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 435, 427, 504, 506/34 of IPC against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on on 14.11.2022 in the morning, informant's neighbours Ramjatan Mahato and Savitri Devi came at the informant's house and abused and assaulted her. The informant informed local police and the police came and pacified the matter. When the police returned, then, at about 3:00 P.M, Ramjatan Mahato and Savitri Devi came at the informant's house and assaulted her sasur Kapildev Mahato and nanad Prabha Devi by means of sharp-edged weapon and lathi due to which, Kapildev Mahato sustained fracture on both his hands and bone of hip-joint also fractured and Prabha Devi sustained cut injury on her head caused by sharp-edged weapon and she fell on the ground. It is further alleged that Vijendra Mahato (petitioner) set fire in the bundles of paddy crops of the informant, which were kept in the field. The occurrence was caused due to land dispute.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is allegation against the petitioner that he set fire in the bundles of paddy crops of the informant, which were kept in the field. Moreover, other co-accused persons have been granted bail by Ld. predecessor of this court vide A.B.P No. 928/2024 and the case of this petitioner is on better footing. There is land dispute between the parties.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed.**

8. It is directed that in the event of his arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioner shall be released on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 438(2) of IPC.
