Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 355/2026

ORDER

16.05.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Manoj Kumar Singh, (2) Nawal Kishore Singh, (3) Kedar Singh, (4) Manju Devi, (5) Lallan Chaudhary, (6) Moharram Ansari**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Daraunda P.S. Case No. 01/2026 registered u/s 318(4), 61(2), 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner no.1 Manoj Singh bears one criminal antecedent and the rest petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that the disputed plot comes in the share of petitioner Manoj Kumar Singh and Nawal Kishore Singh, so there is no question of cheating. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Daraunda P.S. Case No. 01/2026 was registered on 02.01.2026 u/s 318(4), 61(2), 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners. As per FIR, the informant alleged that Manoj Kumar Singh, Nawal Kishore Singh were registered the informant's land khata no. 5 and plot no.550 & 552 to Kedar Singh and Manju Devi without any permission of informant. When the informant objected, all the accused persons were threatening to kill him and his family members.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that it is the case of purely civil nature and from perusal of restatement of the informant mentioned in para-2 of the case diary, it appears that petitioner Manoj Kumar Singh and Nawal Kishore Singh are pattidar of the informant and they registered the land bearing khata no. 5 and plot no.550 & 552 to Kedar Singh and Manju Devi. Charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioners.

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7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-29 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner no.1 Manoj Singh bears one criminal antecedent and the rest petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed.**

9. It is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
