ORDER

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Krishna Kumar @ Krishna Kumar Shah**, who is in judicial custody since 30.01.2026 in connection with Basantpur P.S. Case No. 657/2025 allegedly instituted for the offences under section 309(4), 111 along with 27 Arms Act.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears one criminal antecedent. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Ld. Counsel further submits no incriminating material and the alleged theft article had been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 30.01.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld. counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard, perused record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR Vide- Basantpur P.S. Case No. 657/2025 was allegedly instituted on 02.12.2025 for the offences under section 309(4), 111 along with 27 Arms Act against unknown. As per F.I.R, the informant's father runs a jewellery shop name and style as Manmohit Jewellery, informant alleged that on 02.12.2025 at about 03:30 four robbers aged about 20 to 30 years hide their faces with mask and helmets came riding on two splendor motorcycles, in which two miscreants fired outside his shop and two miscreants entered into the informant's jewellery shop and robbed the jewellery by showing weapon and fled away.

6. From perusal of record, it appears petitioner is not named in the FIR, but his name surfaced in this case on his self confessional statement in Basantpur P.S Case No. 693/2025. From perusal of confessional statement of petitioner, it appears that he has stated in his confessional statement that on 01.12.2025, he along with Rohit Sharma, son of Ayodhya Sharma, Thana-Barharia, District Siwan, at 10:00 AM left Manoj Chaurasia's house riding on his Hero Motorcycle and after crossing

Bahadurpur via Bhaluara Canal, reached Khodipakar. In this sequence, he did a Recce of the shop of Manmohit Gold and Silver shop. Thereafter, he came on the road. While he and his accomplice were returning from Khodipakar, Rohit Sharma sent Rs. 8000/- to our bike. After that, they went to Manoj Chaurasia's house. It was planned there that the work has to be done the next day. On date-02.12.25 petitioner and other co-accused persons executed their plan and looted the jewellery shop in broad day light.

7. From perusal of para-76 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that the fact that the petitioner got Rs. 8000/- towards advance was discovered. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 30.01.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-78 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears one similar criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and gravity of the offence, the present bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Krishna Kumar @ Krishna Kumar Shah**, is hereby **rejected**.
