ORDER

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **(1) Anup Kumar**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with Pachrukhi P.S. Case No. 491/2025 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 324(4), 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel further submits that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Other co-accused persons have been granted bail by this court vide A.B.P No. 3341/2025. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Pachrukhi P.S. Case No. 491/2025 was registered on 13.11.2025 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 324(4), 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 12.11.2025 at about 20:00 O'clock, he was sitting at his Darwaja, then Anup Kumar (petitioner) and Golu Kumar came at his Darwaja armed with lathi-danda and started hurling abuses. Anup Kumar assaulted on the head of informant with lathi. Golu Kumar assaulted on the back of informant with lathi. When the wife of the informant came for his rescue Baijnath Yadav, Bittu Kumar, Birendra Yadav assaulted the informant and his wife with lathi.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is specific allegation against the petitioner that he assaulted on the head of informant, as the result informant sustained injury on his head. From perusal of injury report of informant, it appears that he sustained injury on his eyebrow and doctor opined the nature of injury is simple. Thus, the injury is not intandem with

the allegation. Moreover, similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted bail by this court vide order dated 12.12.2025 in A.B.P No. 3341/2025.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-27 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**.

9. It is directed that in the event of his arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioner shall be released on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
