ORDER

10.03.2026

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Rajbanshi Ram @ Banshilal Ram**, who is in judicial custody since 16.02.2026 in connection with Raghunathpur P.S. Case No. 67/1999 allegedly instituted for the offences under section 341, 323, 307/34 of IPC.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears one criminal antecedent. The allegation as alleged against the petitioner is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.02.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld. counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard, perused record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Raghunathpur P.S. Case No. 67/1999 was allegedly instituted on 02.11.1999 for the offences under section 341, 323, 307/34 of IPC against the petitioner along with three unknown persons. As per fardbeyan, the informant alleged that on 29.10.1999, he had gone to Darauli and when the informant was returning and reached near Boring of Sarpanch Sahab, petitioner along with three-four persons were sitting there armed with gun, lathi-bhala and bomb, caught the informant. Thereafter, petitioner assaulted on the head of informant with the butt of gun. After that all the accused persons assaulted with lathi-danda.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is specific allegation against the petitioner of assaulting on the head of informant with the butt of gun. From perusal of injury report of informant, it appears that informant sustained following injuries:-

(i) Penetrating wound on Rt. side scalp size 1/2"x 1/2"x Scalp Deep

(ii) Lacerated wound Lt. side scalp 1/1/2"x 1/2"x Scalp Deep.

(iii) Bruise and abrasion on austral part of head 1 x 1"

Injury no.1 caused by sharp penetrating weapon and injury no.2 & 3 by hard and blunt weapon. Doctor opined the nature of injury is simple, but injury is intendam with the allegation. Petitioner is in custody since 16.02.2026, but caused inordinate delay of 27 years and the case did not progress at all on account of the fact that petitioner kept absconding for last 27 years.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears one criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and specific allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner **Rajbanshi Ram @ Banshilal Ram** on bail, therefore the present bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner is hereby **rejected with liberty to renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge.**
