ORDER

02.04.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Sonali Kumari, (2) Manju Devi, (3) Krishna Singh**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Pachrukhi P.S Case No. 41/2026 registered u/s 109, 3(5) of BNS & 25(1-B)(i), 26, 27 of Arms Act.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel further submits that there is no allegation as alleged in the FIR is made out against the petitioners. There is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Pachrukhi P.S Case No. 41/2026 was registered on 13.02.2026 u/s 109, 3(5) of BNS along with 25(1-B)(i), 26, 27 of Arms Act against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per fardbeyan, the informant alleged that on 12.02.2026, he came to Bhawani More from his byke and parked his byke in front of his market and went to attend the Barat ceremony in New Kalawati Marriage Hall with his friend Santosh Kumar Singh. It is alleged that two unknown persons riding on a motorcycle came and the person, who is sitting at rear seat of the motorcycle shot below the right side of chest and fled away towards Siwan Town. Informant is full belief that Sardhanand Kumar, his son and daughter, Jai Govind Singh, Bhanu Pratap Singh, Krishna Singh, The wife of Krishna Singh have involved in the occurrence.

6. From perusal of FIR, it appears that the FIR is registered on mere suspicion against the petitioners along with other co-accused persons. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and the fact that there is omnibus and general allegation against the petitioners, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed.**

It is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
