ORDER

10.03.2026

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Harindra Yadav**, who is in judicial custody since 20.02.2026 in connection with Daraunda P.S Case No. 336/2024 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 117(2), 109, 352, 351(3), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears three criminal antecedents. Ld. counsel further submits that the allegations as alleged against the petitioner is false, imaginary and after thought. The occurrence is of 26.07.2024, but the FIR has been registered on 27.07.2024 without any explanation. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 20.02.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P as well as learned counsel for the informant oppose the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Daraunda P.S Case No. 336/2024 was registered on 27.07.2024 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 117(2), 109, 352, 351(3), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 26.07.2024 at about 7:00 P.M, informant's son Rama Shankar Yadav was coming to his house after purchasing vegetables from Arjal Bazar, as soon, he reached near the house of Nandu Pandey, suddenly one Scorpio came and stopped in front of motorcycle of the informant's son. Thereafter, from the Scorpio, the petitioner along with other co-accused persons alighted. Nagendra Yadav armed with iron pipe assaulted informant's son on his head and petitioner Harendra Yadav armed with chaku assaulted him with intention to kill, as the result informant's son became seriously injured and fell on the ground. It is further alleged that Ramesh Yadav armed with iron pipe assaulted the informant's son and also co-accused Ravi Kant assaulted him by means of iron rod. Thus, informant's son sustained fracture on his both hands and both legs. It is further alleged that co-accused Sakaldev Yadav ordered in abusive language to kill the informant's son. It is further

alleged that petitioner Harendra Yadav threatened the informant that all three sons of the informant would be killed within 10 days.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is specific allegation against the petitioner. From perusal of supplementary injury report of informant's son Ramashankar Yadav, it appears that he sustained following injuries:-

- (i) Pain and swelling below both knee.
- (ii) CLW below both knee right small left 6 cm x 1cm
- (iii) Left side of forehead 2cm x 1/2cm

Doctor opined the nature of injury is grievous. Petitioner is in custody since 20.02.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears three criminal antecedents as (1) Daraunda P.S Case No. 303/2023 registered u/s 341, 323, 379, 504, 506 of IPC, (2) Daraunda P.S Case No. 186/2017 registered u/s 302/34 of IPC and (3) Daraunda P.S Case No. 102/2018 registered u/s 272, 273 & 30 (A) Bihar Excise Act and as per para-127 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears one criminal antecedent vide 239/2015 u/s 147, 148, 149, 342, 307 of IPC, which is not mentioned in the para no.3 of criminal antecedent of bail petition. Thus, petitioner actively concealed his one criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and nature of injuries and active concealment of one criminal antecedent, the present bail petition filed on behalf of petitioner **Harindra Yadav** is hereby **rejected**.
