ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves present bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Raj Kumar Sharma**, who is in judicial custody since 13.02.2026 in connection with Hussainganj P.S Case No. 66/2026 registered u/s 338, 336(3), 340(2), 318(4), 317(5), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. The prosecution story is totally false, concocted and baseless. Ld. Counsel further submits that nothing has been recovered either from the person or possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.02.2026. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Hussainganj P.S Case No. 66/2026 was registered on 12.02.2026 u/s 338, 336(3), 340(2), 318(4), 317(5), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 12.02.2026 at about 16:05 O'clock, he was on evening patrolling duty with other police personnel and started vehicle checking near State bank branch, Gopalpur at about 17:30. During vehicle checking, three persons came riding on Hero Splendor Plus Motorcycle bearing registration no. BR29AP7420 towards Gopalapur market, when informant signaled to stop, they tried to flee away, but with the help of police force, two persons were trapped and on query, they disclosed their name as Raj

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Kumar Sharma and Raju Mohammad Ansari and the name of fleeing person as Golu Kumar. On demand of paper of motorcycle, they did not produce valid paper of the motorcycle and stated that the motorcycle is stolen property.

6. From perusal of the record, it appears that the petitioner was apprehended on spot with Hero Splendor Plus Motorcycle bearing registration no. BR29AP7420. T.I.P was not conducted by the police. Charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner. Moreover, petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.02.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-14 of the case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the fact and custody period of the petitioner, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below **with condition that the petitioner shall not repeat such offence in future. If the petitioner is subsequently found indulged in similar offences, the learned trial court shall take steps for cancellation of his bail bond.**
