Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 647/2026

ORDER

29.04.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Diwakar Singh (2) Asha Devi**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Maharajganj P.S. Case No. 55/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351 (2), 352, 3(5) of BNS.
2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.
4. Heard. Perused the record.
5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Maharajganj P.S. Case No. 55/2026 was registered on 18.02.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351 (2), 352, 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 14.02.2026 at 8:30 P.M (evening) she was sitting in front of her house, in the meantime, petitioners along with other co-accused persons started hurling abuses and marpit with the informant. It is alleged that Rajendra Singh assaulted on the head of informant with rod.
6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. From perusal of injury report of informant it appears that she sustained simple head injury. Moreover, there is specific allegation of assaulting on the head of informant is on Rajendra Singh, but Rajendra Singh is not petitioner herein.
7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as report of S.H.O, Maharajganj, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

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8. Considering the aforesaid facts and the fact that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**.

9. It is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
