Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 656/2026

Ziradei P.S. Case No. 13/2026

ORDER

08.05.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **(1) Prince Kumar Singh**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with Ziradei P.S. Case No. 13/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears three criminal antecedents. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that the present case has been lodged only as a counterblast to the said case to save the informant from legal consequences. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P as well as Ld. counsel for informant oppose the prayer for anticipatory bail and Ld. counsel for informant submitted that I.O of this case has deliberately concealed the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and he claims there is two more case lodged against the petitioner.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Ziradei P.S. Case No. 13/2026 was registered on 22.01.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 21.01.2026 at about 09:00 A.M, he has sitting at his Verandah, in the meantime, Prince Singh (petitioner) attacked the head of the informant with pistol, thereafter Rishu Singh, Bidyasagar Singh, Rita Devi and Anshika Devi assaulted the informant with iron rod, spade and farsa.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is specific allegation against the petitioner that he assaulted on the head of informant with pistol.

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From perusal of injury report of informant, it appears that he sustained following injuries:-

- (i) Laceration wound of 2.5 cm x 1cm over parietal region of head.
- (ii) Abrasion of 0.5 cm x 0.5cm on right hand little finger
- (iii) Blunt Trauma wound of 7cm x 1cm, 10cmx 0.5cm, 12cm x 2cm on upper back region
- (iv) Blunt Trauma wound of 5cm x 1cm and 2cm x 1cm on lower back

The injuries were found simple. However, the informant sustained one injury on the vital part, i.e on the head. Thus, the injuries are intendant with the allegation.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-36 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears three criminal antecedents. Ld. counsel for the informant filed case diary of Mairwa P.S Case No. 270/2018 and from perusal of the same, it appears that petitioner has got two more criminal antecedent vide Mairwa P.S Case No. 242/2018 and Mairwa P.S Case No. 265/2018. Thus, the petitioner has actively concealed his two criminal antecedents.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and actively concealment of two criminal antecedents the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioner **(1) Prince Kumar Singh** is hereby **rejected**.
