ORDER

08.07.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **(1) Ankit Singh**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with Bhawanpur Hat P.S. Case No. 65/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117, 109, 352, 351(2), 303(2), 3(5) of BNS.
2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears five criminal antecedents. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. counsel further submits that the petitioner was not present at the place of occurrence and the name of this petitioner has falsely transpired by the informant due to previous enmity. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P, opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.
4. Heard. Perused the record.
5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Bhagwanpur Hat P.S Case No. 65/2026 was registered on 14.02.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(i), 117 109, 352, 351(2), 303(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 14.02.2026 at about 09:30 o'clock, co-accused persons surrounded the informant near Sakari Panchayat Bhawan and told to informant's father to withdraw the case. When the informant's father refused to withdraw the case, Ankit Singh (petitioner) put the pistol on the chest of informant and Golu Kumar Singh assaulted the informant's munshi Anendra Singh with iron rod, as the result Anendra Singh sustained fracture injury on his left hand. It is further alleged that Ankit Kumar Singh fired on the informant.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is specific allegation against the petitioner that he put the pistol on the chest of informant and fired on the informant. From perusal of injury report of informant, it appears that he sustained simple injury

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-23 of photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioners bears five criminal antecedents, but from perusal of para-31 of photo copy of case diary, it appears that apart from five criminal antecedents the petitioner bears one more criminal antecedent bearing Bhagwanpur Hat P.S Case No. 48/2023 registered u/s 341,323,c337, 379, 504, 506/34 of IPC & 3(i)(r)(s) Sc/St. Thus, the petitioner has actively concealed his one criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, criminal antecedents against the petitioner and the fact that petitioner has actively concealed his one criminal antecedent, the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioner **Ankit Singh** is hereby **rejected**.
