Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 665/2026

ORDER

26.05.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Anoop Shahi @ Bittu Shahi, (2) Ankit Shahi, (3) Bashisth Shahi, (4) Prashant Shahi**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Maharajganj P.S. Case No. 34/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 352, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that the petitioners and informant are of same village and some civil dispute is going on between the parties. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P as well as learned counsel for informant oppose the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R *vide* Maharajganj P.S. Case No. 34/2026 was registered on 03.02.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 352, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 01.02.2026 at about 12:00 o'clock, he was sitting at his Darwaja. In the meantime, petitioners came at the Darwaja of the informant and attacked informant. It is alleged that Prashant Shahi assaulted on the head of informant with lathi and other petitioners also assaulted the informant with lathi-danda and fist and slaps. When, the wife of the informant came for his rescue, all the petitioners assaulted her.

6. From perusal of injury report of informant, it appears that he sustained simple injury.

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7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-49 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**.

9. It is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
