Bail Petition No. 302/2026

ORDER

30.04.2026

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Ramayan Chaudhary**, who is in judicial custody since 28.02.2026 in connection with Siwan Muffasil P.S Case No. 110/2026 registered u/s 103 (1), 238, 3(5) of BNS & 27 Arms Act.
2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner bears fifteen criminal antecedents. Ld. Counsel further submits that the deceased was died due to brain haemorrhage. Petitioner was not present at the place of occurrence. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 28.02.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.
4. Heard, perused record.
5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Siwan Muffasil P.S Case No. 110/2026 was registered on 24.02.2026 u/s 103 (1), 238, 3(5) of BNS & 27 Arms Act against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per fardbeyan, the informant alleged that on 23.02.2026 at about 10:00 P.M, his father was sleeping in the Veranda after taking meal. At about 10:30 P.M, informant heard a sound of firing in his Veranda, thereafter came out from his room and saw that his co-villager Ramayan Chaudhary, Sonu Kumar and two unknown persons were fleeing from the veranda of the informant and his father fell from the bed and blood was oozing from his head. After that informant's father was brought to Sadar hospital, Siwan and doctor declared him dead.

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6. From perusal of record, it appears that it is the case of murder of informant's father. The post-mortem report is available with photo copy of case diary and from perusal of the post-mortem report of deceased, it appears that gunshot mark over nasal bone with bleeding entry wound and cause of death severe hemorrhage in brain due to gun shot leading to death. Thus, the injury is intendam with the allegation. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 28.02.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears 15 criminal antecedents and from perusal of para-18 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears twenty five criminal antecedents. Thus, the petitioner has actively concealed his ten criminal antecedents.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and gravity of the offence and actively concealment of criminal antecedent of the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner **Ramayan Chaudhary** on bail, therefore the present bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner **Ramayan Chaudhary** is hereby **rejected**.
