ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves present bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Shambhu Singh**, who is in judicial custody since 25.02.2026 in connection with Maharajganj P.S. Case No. 237/2024 registered u/s 341, 323, 324, 307, 504, 506/34 of I.P.C against the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has got one criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel further submits that there is a counter case vide Maharajganj P.S Case No. 238/2024 and both the cases were compromised between the parties. Other co-accused person has been enlarged on bail by this court vide order dated 03.03.2025 in B.P no. 136/2025. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.02.2026. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld P.P opposes the prayer of bail.
4. Heard. Perused the record.
5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Maharajganj P.S. Case No. 237/2024 registered on 08.06.2024 u/s 341, 323, 324, 307, 504, 506/34 of I.P.C against the petitioner along with one co-accused Sonu Kumar. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 07.06.2024, the informant along with his brother was returning from Maharajganj Bazar. As soon as, they reached in front of Harendra Tea Stall, the petitioner along with his son Sonu Kumar (other co-accused person) were standing there from before and instructed to stop the motorcycle, then the informant stopped his motorcycle. Thereafter, on order of Shambhu Singh, Sonu Singh with intention to kill, gave knife blow on the chest of Niraj Singh.

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6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is allegation against the petitioner that he dragged the informant's brother from motorcycle and ordered to kill, except this there is no any allegation attributed against the petitioner. On whom there is specific allegation of giving stab wound in the chest of informant's brother, is on co-accused Sonu Kumar Singh, but Sonu Kumar Singh is not petitioner in the bail petition and he is enlarged on bail by this court vide order dated 03.03.2025 in B.P No. 136/2025. Moreover petitioner is in judicial custody since 25.02.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-40 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears one criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and custody period of the petitioner, the present bail application is **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the court below.
