Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 719/2026

G.B Nagar P.S. Case No. 119/2026

ORDER

15.04.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Zahid Sai, (2) Irshad Sai**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with G.B Nagar P.S Case No. 119/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner no.1 bears no criminal antecedent and petitioner no.2 bears two antecedents. The allegation levelled against these petitioners is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. counsel further submits that the petitioners have regularly paid the electric bill to concerned department. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the case record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR Vide-G.B Nagar P.S Case No. 119/2026 was registered on 10.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 303(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners along with unknown. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that he is supervisor at Jamo electricity department, block-Barharia and on 09.03.2026 at about 2:45 o'clock, he along with other staffs of electricity department went to the business place of Irsad Sai during revenue collection. During checking, Rs. 15,930/- was dues against the petitioners. It is alleged that when the informant and checking team told to deposit the dues money, Jahid Sai, started abusing and he assaulted on the head of informant with wooden cutter and snatched collected money Rs. 53,290/.

6. From perusal of record, there is specific allegation against the petitione Jahid Sai that he assaulted on the head of the informant, while the informant was discharging his official duty. As a result, the informant sustained simple head injury. Thus, the injury is intandam with the allegation.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-29 of photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner Zahid Sai bears no criminal antecedent.

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8. Considering the aforesaid facts and specific allegation, the present anticipatory bail application qua petitioner **(1) Zahid Sai** is hereby **rejected**.

9. So far as, the bail petition of petitioner **(1) Irshad Sai**, is concerned, there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner.

10. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears two criminal antecedents, but from perusal of para-29 of photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner Irshad Sai bears no criminal antecedent.

11. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail petition of petitioner **Irshad Sai** is **allowed**.

12. It is directed that in the event of his arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioner shall be released on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
