ORDER

15.05.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Sanjit Manjhi @ Sanjit Kumar, (2) Dularchand Manjhi @ Lalchand Manjhi, (3) Dipu Manjhi, (4) Buni Rawat, (5) Akash Kumar, (6) Nanhak Kumar @ Chhote Lal Kumar**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Lakri Nabiganj P.S Case No. 47/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 77, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner no. 2 bears one criminal antecedent and other petitioners are clean past. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that there is land dispute between the parties. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R *vide* Lakri Nabiganj P.S Case No. 47/2026 was registered on 06.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 77, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 05.03.2026 at about 11:00 A.M, Sanjit Manjhi was taking photo of women, who were bathing in the informant's Angan and on objection, Sanjit Manjhi became aggressive and hurling abuses. It is alleged that when the informant's son was discharging urine, Sanjit Manjhi, Dularchand Manjhi, Dipu Manjhi started assaulting the informant's son Manu Kumar and when the informant, his wife and son came to his rescue, in the meantime, Bunni Rawat, Akash Kumar, Nanhak Kumar came and started assaulting. It is further alleged that Dipu Manjhi assaulted Manu with spade.

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6. From perusal of injury report of informant's son, it appears that he sustained simple injury.
7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner no.2 bears one criminal antecedent, but from perusal of para-25 of the case diary, it appears that all the petitioners bear clean past and petitioner no.1 bears one criminal antecedent.
8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**.
9. It is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
