Anticipatory Bail Petition No.782/2026

ORDER

17.04.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **(1) Juhi Khatoon @ Tabsum Khatoon**, who apprehends her arrest in connection with M.H Nagar P.S. Case No. 116/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 109, 303(2), 74, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather she has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that the petitioner and informant are close pattidar and land dispute is going on between the parties. There is no chance of her absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R *vide* M.H Nagar P.S. Case No. 116/2026 was registered on 15.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 109, 303(2), 74, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that Irfan Ahmad, Kaif Ahmad, Juhi Khatoon (petitioner) damaged the informant's vegetable field. When, the informant objected, they started hurling abuses and attacked with brick and stone. It is further alleged that all the accused persons entered into the informant's house and assaulted the informant and his sons with rod, hansuwa, garansi. It is alleged that Kaif Ahmad assaulted on the head of informant's son Taufik Rahman with rod. Accused persons also assaulted on the head of Samir Rahman.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is omnibus allegation against the petitioner. From perusal of injury reports of injured, it appears that they sustained simple injury.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-17 of the case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

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8. Considering the aforesaid facts and the fact that there is omnibus and general allegation against the petitioner, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed.**

9. It is directed that in the event of her arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioner shall be released on furnishing by her bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
