**ORDER**

**15.04.2026**

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **(1) Dhananjay Kumar, (2) Suraj Prasad, (3) Sonu Kumar Pandit**, who are in judicial custody since 05.03.2026 in connection with Siswan P.S Case No. 43/2026 registered u/s 303(2), 317(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel further submits that nothing incriminating article has been recovered either from their person or possession of the petitioners. Petitioners are in judicial custody since 05.03.2026. There is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Siswan P.S Case No. 43/2026 was registered on 05.03.2026 u/s 303(2), 317(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners. As per FIR, the informant alleged that he is posted as circle guard in Siswan police station and on 05.03.2026 at about 10:00 o'clock, he saw that one truck standing in circle office compound and their tyres have stolen. Thereafter, informant got knowledge that Dhananjay Kumar, Sonu Kumar Pandit, were loading tyre in one truck. Seeing the police, petitioners started fleeing, but two were nabbed and disclosed their name as Dhananjay Kumar, Suraj Prasad and the name of fleeing person as Sonu Kumar Pandit.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner Dhananjay Kumar and Suraj Prasad were nabbed on spot and on their confessional statement the name of the petitioner Sonu Kumar Pandit surfaced in this case. Charge-

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sheet was submitted against the petitioners. Moreover, petitioners are in judicial custody since 05.03.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-22 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and custody period of the petitioners, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioners are directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below.
