ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Lallu Yadav@ Suraj Yadav** apprehending his arrest in connection with Siwan Muffasil P.S Case No. 644/2024 registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is quite innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that no bail application on behalf of this petitioner either regular or anticipatory has been filed or pressed either before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court at Patna, earlier. The petitioner has got clean past. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this false and concocted case due to save skin from the real counter blast case bearing Siwan(M) P.S Case No. 648/2024. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the prosecution evidence or the witnesses. Thus, learned counsel prays that petitioner may be granted anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, learned P.P vehemently opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submitted that petitioner along with other co-accused assaulted the informant and his brother by means of knife, due to which they sustained injury. Thus, learned P.P prays that petitioner does not deserve to be pre-arrest bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that the F.I.R was registered against the petitioner and others *vide* Siwan Muffasil P.S Case No. 644/2024 registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S, 2023. In the F.I.R, the allegation against the petitioner that the petitioner Lallu Yadav along with other co-accused assaulted the informant and his with knife.

6. However, from perusal of injury report, it appears that the injuries sustained by the injured persons are simple in nature. From LCR, it transpires that

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earlier co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this Court and Hon'ble High Court, Patna *vide* order dated 24.05.2026, 16.04.2025 and 17.04.2025 in A.B.P No. 1264/2025, Criminal Miscellaneous No. 16572/2025 and 19664/2025 respectively. As per Para No. 36 of the case diary as well as Para No. 3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears clean criminal antecedent.

7. Considering aforesaid fact and the fact that nature of injury is not in tandem with the allegation leveled by informant. The present anticipatory bail application is **allowed**.

8. It is directed that, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within six weeks from today the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Court below subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of B.N.S.S.
