This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely **Amit Ray @ Lav Kumar** in apprehending his arrest in connection with Basantpur (LNG) P.S. Case No. 672/2023 registered u/s 341, 323, 325, 379, 307, 427, 504/34 of I.P.C and later on section 302 of I.P.C added against the petitioner along with others, put up and pressed.

Heard both sides.

As per the written petition of the informant Suganti Devi, the prosecution case, in short, is that on 04.12.2023, the petitioner along with others and 10 unknown persons were ploughing the khatiyani land of the informant by tractor. When, husband of the informant protested, all the accused persons started assaulted him by means of iron rod and lathi-danda, thereafter, family members of the informant came to pacify the matter, then all accused persons also assaulted them brutally due to which, Rudal Rai's hand got fractured. It further alleged that co-accused Ranjeet, Narayan, Pankaj and Ambika assaulted to the husband of the informant, who is undergoing treatment in Gorakhpur. Hand of the Raj Kishore Rai also fractured.

Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Other accused persons are on bail granted by the Hon'ble Patna High Court vide Criminal Misc. No. 28327 of 2024 dated 20.05.2024. There is no specific allegation against this petitioner. There is case and counter case in between the parties. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, he prays for anticipatory bail.

On the other hand, Ld. A.P.P strongly opposes prayer of bail.

Having gone through the aforesaid facts and submissions as advanced on behalf of both sides and after perusal of record, it appears that this case has been registered u/s 341, 323, 325, 379, 307, 427, 504/34 of I.P.C and later on section 302 of I.P.C added against the petitioner along with others. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Father of petitioner namely Manan

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Rai and mother Rajpati Devi granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. There is total 15 named accused, out of them, 13 accused were granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna vide Criminal Misc. Nos. 28327 of 2024 and 74680 of 2024. Accused Pankaj Kumar granted regular bail by the Hon'ble Patna High Court vide Criminal Misc. No. 55258 of 2025 and accused Kiran Kumari @ Kajal Kumari was granted anticipatory bail by this court vide A.B.P. No. 1351/2024 on parity ground. Case of this petitioner appears to be similarly situated. There is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner as mentioned at para no. 29 of the case diary.

So, considering the aforesaid facts and similarly situated bail granted by the Hon'ble Patna High Court, it seems proper to grant privilege of bail to the petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before learned trial court within four weeks from today after furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned trial court subject to condition as mentioned u/s 482 of BNSS.
