**ORDER**

**08.05.2026**

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **(1) Pawan Sharma @ Pawan Kumar Sharma, (2) Aman Sharma @ Bittu**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Nautan P.S. Case No. 87/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(1), 117(1), 118(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. There is land dispute between the parties since long. Ld. Counsel further submits that at the time of so called occurrence, the informant and her son along with other co-accused persons dispossess the petitioners from their own land, thereafter hot talk and dhaka-mukki started between the parties after that the informant fell down on iron scrap due to which, he sustained injury. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P as well as Ld. counsel for informant oppose the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Nautan P.S Case No. 87/2026 was registered on 11.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(1), 117(1), 118(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that she and her husband were talking to each other on Dwar. In the meantime, the petitioners along with other co-accused persons started assaulting the informant's husband with rod, lathi from back side, when the informant came to her rescue, all the accused persons pushed the informant's husband and assaulted him.

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6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. From perusal of injury report of informant's husband Tuntun Thakur, it appears that he sustained grievous head injury.

From perusal of injury report of informant's husband, it appears that he sustained following injuries:-

- (i) Lacerated wound on parietal region size 4cmx 1cm
- (ii) Lacerated wound on right side forehead near right eyebrow size 2cm x 1cm
- (iii) Abrasion on right side of thoracic region.
- (iv) Blunt Trauma wound of 5cm x 1cm and 2cm x 1cm on lower back

The injuries were found grievous according to NCCT Head. However, the injured sustained two injuries on the vital part, i.e on the head.

7. As per para-9 of the bail petition as well as para-53 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and nature of injury, the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioners **(1) Pawan Sharma @ Pawan Kumar Sharma, (2) Aman Sharma @ Bittu** is hereby **rejected**.
