ORDER

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **(1) Rajesh Singh**, who is in judicial custody since 13.03.2026 in connection with G.B Nagar P.S Case No. 84/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 326(a), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel further submits that there is no allegation as alleged in the FIR is made out against the petitioner. There is land dispute between the parties for which a title suit vide title suit no. 892/2024 is going on. There is counter case too. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.03.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide G.B Nagar P.S Case No. 84/2026 was registered on 17.02.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 326(a), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 16.02.2026 at about 04:30 P.M (evening), informant's villagers, petitioner along with other co-accused persons attacked armed with lathi-danda, rod, talwar, farsa to informant. It is alleged that Rajesh Kumar Singh assaulted on the head of informant with rod. Rakesh Kumar Singh assaulted on the head of Rahul Kumar with sword. It is further alleged that Vinay Kumar Singh assaulted Hemanti Devi with lathi. Vijay Singh pushed Kunti Devi catching his hair.

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6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is specific allegation against the petitioner that he assaulted on the head of informant with rod, but the rod hit on the hand of the informant. From perusal of injury reports of injured, it appears that they sustained simple injury. Moreover, other co-accused Ramashankar Singh has been admitted to bail by this court vide order dated 04.04.2026 in B.P No. 310/2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-45 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. Moreover, petitioner is languishing in jail custody since 13.03.2026.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below.
