Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 879/2026

ORDER

09.07.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **Shakil Ahmad**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with Lakarinabiganj P.S. Case No. 50/2026 registered u/s 303(2) of BNS.
2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel further submits that no any incriminating article has been recovered either from the person or possession of the petitioner. There is counter case too. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.
4. Heard. Perused the record.
5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR Vide-Lakarinabiganj P.S. Case No. 50/2026 was registered on 10.03.2026 u/s 303(2) of BNS against the petitioner. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that he does a business of fish. On 06.03.2026 at about 05:00 A.M, informant went to his pond and saw that Md. Shakil was stealing his Motor S. No. MBA21-500721. When, the informant objected, Md. Shakil pulled out a knife and threatened the informant.
6. From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is named accused of the FIR and as per FIR, there is allegation against the petitioner that he has stolen the motor S.No. MBA21-500721 of informant. From perusal of seizure list mentioned in para-4 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that the stolen motor S.No. MBA21-500721 was recovered from the Dalan of the petitioner. Investigation is going on.

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7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-36 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and gravity of the offence, the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioner **Shakil Ahmad** is hereby **rejected**.
