ORDER

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **(1) Pramod Singh @ Munchun Singh @ Pramod Kumar Singh**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with Bhagwanpur Hat P.S. Case No. 83/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 308(2), 118(1), 109, 117, 352, 351(2) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears one criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P as well as learned counsel for informant oppose the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Bhagwanpur Hat P.S Case No. 83/2026 was registered on 03.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 308(2), 118(1), 109, 117, 352, 351(2) of BNS against the petitioner. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 02.03.2026 at about 06:00 A.M, Santosh Singh @ Bhim Singh, Pramod Singh @ Munchun Singh (petitioner) came armed with lathi, farsa, bhala and iron rod and started hurling abuses and demanding extortion of Rs. 20,000/- per month. It is alleged that on the order of Pramod Singh, Santosh Singh gave bhala blow in the leg of informant.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is allegation against the petitioner that he along with co-accused Santosh Singh demanded Rs. 20,000/- to the informant and ordered to Santosh Singh to kill the informant except this there is no any allegation attributed against the petitioner.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-20 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

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8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed.**

9. It is directed that in the event of his arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioner shall be released on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
