Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 888/2026

Durondha P.S. Case No. 332/2025

ORDER

06.05.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Bishundev Ram, (2) Binay Kumar, (3) Manish Kumar, (4) Lakshman Kumar Prasad**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Durondha P.S. Case No. 332/2025 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 76, 351(2), 352, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners bear one criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that the date of occurrence is 30.06.2025, but the FIR has been registered on 03.07.2025 without any plausible explanation. Other co-accused person has been granted bail by this court vide order dated 02.01.2026 in A.B.P No. 3398/2025. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R *vide* Durondha P.S. Case No. 332/2025 was registered on 03.07.2025 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 76, 351(2), 352, 303(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 30.06.2025 at about 9:00 P.M (night), she was walking on her Dwar in front of her house. In the meantime, informant's neighbourer Laxman Prasad, Vinay Kumar, Manish Ram, Bishnu Deo Ram, Lilawati Devi, Prince Kumar pushed her on ground and dragged away in field and tore the cloth of the informant and assaulted her.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. From perusal of injury report of informant,

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it appears that she sustained simple injury. Moreover, other similarly co-accused person has been admitted to bail by this court vide order dated 02.02.2026 in A.B.P No. 3398/2025.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-38 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and the fact that there is omnibus and general allegation against the petitioners, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**.

9. It is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
