ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves present bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Santosh Singh @ Bhim Singh**, who is in judicial custody since 05.03.2026 in connection with Bhagwanpur Hat P.S Case No. 83/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 308(2), 118(1), 109, 117, 352, 351(2) of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The prosecution story is totally false, concocted and baseless. Petitioner bears one criminal antecedent. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 05.03.2026. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld P.P as well as learned counsel for the informant vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.
4. Heard. Perused the record.
5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Bhagwanpur Hat P.S Case No. 83/2026 was registered on 03.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 308(2), 118(1), 109, 117, 352, 351(2) of BNS against the petitioner. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 02.03.2026 at about 06:00 A.M, Santosh Singh @ Bhim Singh (petitioner), Pramod Singh @ Munchun Singh came armed with lathi, farsa, bhala and iron rod and started hurling abuses and demanding extortion of Rs. 20,000/- per month. It is alleged that on the order of Pramod Singh, Santosh Singh gave bhala blow in the leg of informant.
6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is specific allegation against the petitioner. From perusal of injury report of informant, it appears that he

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sustained grievous injury. Moreover, petitioner is in judicial custody since 05.03.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, as well as para-22 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears one criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and custody period of the petitioner, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below.
