ORDER

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Ajit @ Ramu**, who is in judicial custody since 12.03.2026 in connection with Basantpur P.S. Case No. 65/2026 allegedly instituted for the offences under section 310(2) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has got clean past. Ld. Counsel further submits that petitioner is not named in the FIR. Nothing incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is a student of B.A and he is preparing for competitive examination. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 12.03.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld. counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard, perused record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR Vide- Basantpur P.S. Case No. 65/2026 was allegedly instituted on 09.03.2026 for the offences under section 310(2) of BNS against unknown. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 09.03.2026 at about 2:40 P.M, he was at his shop styled as Arun Jewellers and Bartan Bhandar, which was only 10 meters far from the Basantpur police station, six miscreants armed with firearms entered into the shop and looted the jewellery, utensils and cash of Rs. 4,00,000/-.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is not named in the FIR, but his name surfaced in this case on his self confessional statement and on his self confessional statement a raid was conducted by the police at the house of petitioner and some of looted jewellery were alleged to have been recovered from the house and possession of petitioner. It suggests the

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involvement of the petitioner in the alleged occurrence. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 12.03.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-90 of the case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and gravity of the offence of broad light loot/dacoity at jeweller's shop in the midst of market, the present bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Ajit @ Ramu** is hereby **rejected**.
