ORDER

07.05.2026

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Vyas Yadav**, who is in judicial custody since 16.03.2026 in connection with Darauli P.S. Case No. 139/2026 allegedly instituted for the offences under section 303(2), 317(2) of BNS & 25(1-B)(a), 26 (1) of Arms Act.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has got criminal antecedents. Ld. Counsel further submits that petitioner has no concern with the black Hero Splendor Motorcycle. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 16.03.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld. counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard, perused record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR Vide- Darauli P.S. Case No. 139/2026 was allegedly instituted on 15.03.2026 for the offences under section 303(2), 317(2) of BNS & 25(1-B)(a), 26 (1) of Arms Act. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that on 15.03.2026 at about 15:30 O'clock, the informant was to conduct special raid and at about 16:20 O'clock he was checking vehicle near Ukreri More on Darauli-Guthni main road. During vehicle checking, he saw that one person was coming on a black coloured motorcycle towards Tarnwa Bazaar. Informant signaled him to stop, but he tried to flee, but with the help of police force, he nabbed and disclosed his name as Vyas Yadav and on demand of paper of the said motorcycle bearing Chesis No. MBLHAW231RHGC2727 and on query the petitioner stated that the recovered motorcycle is a theft motorcycle. On search, one country made katta and two live cartridges were recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is sole named accused of the FIR and he was arrested on spot by police with without number plate black coloured Hero Splendor Motorcycle and two live cartridges. Petitioner is in custody since 16.03.2026.

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7. As per para- 3 of the bail petition it has not been mentioned as to how many criminal antecedents the petitioner has, but from perusal of para-20 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears as many as 22 criminal antecedents. Thus, petitioner actively concealed his 22 criminal antecedents.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, gravity of the offence and the fact that petitioner actively concealed his 22 criminal history, the present bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Vyas Yadav** is hereby **rejected**.
