Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 926/2026

ORDER

29.04.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Chhotelal Yadav, (2) Durga Yadav**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Darauli P.S. Case No. 148/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. Both the parties are khas pattidar and there is land dispute between them. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P, opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Darauli P.S. Case No. 148/2026 was registered on 25.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 24.03.2026, the informant was grazing his buffalow on Gauri More, in the meantime, petitioners armed with lathi and rod came, thereafter Durga Yadav (petitioner) assaulted on the head of informant with rod and Chhotelal Yadav (petitioner) assaulted on the neck of informant with lathi.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is specific allegation against the petitioners. From perusal of injury report of informant, it appears that he sustained following injuries:-

(i) A Lacerated wound on left hand

(ii) Nose bleeding

After x-ray report doctor found fracture of nasal bone and opined the nature of injury is grievous.

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7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-22 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and gravity of the offence, the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioners **(1) Chhotelal Yadav, (2) Durga Yadav** is hereby **rejected**.
