ORDER

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Prince Verma @ Prince Kumar Verma**, who is in judicial custody since 31.03.2026 in connection with Guthani P.S. Case No. 62/2026 allegedly instituted for the offences under section 307, 331(2) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has got clean past. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Ld. Counsel further submits that the recovered ornaments from the shop of the petitioner namely Janta Jewellery belongs to the petitioner and the same was not the stolen property. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 31.03.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, Ld counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard, perused record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR Vide-Guthani P.S. Case No. 62/2026 was allegedly instituted on 18.02.2026 for the offences under section 307, 331(2) of BNS against known. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that on 18.02.2026 at about 2:00 o'clock (night) unknown thieves have stolen 50 gm golden jewellery worth of Rs. 7,50,000/- and 2 k.g silver jewellery worth of Rs. 4,00,000/- including the ornaments kept by customers from the shop of informant and the informant got knowledge about the theft from his house owner through phone.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that petitioner is not named in the FIR, but his name is transpired in this case on the confessional statement of Tiger Jaiswal and on the confession of Tiger Jaiswal, a search was made

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from the shop of petitioner and on search, the recovered jewellerys were found from his shop. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 31.03.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-42 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and gravity of the offence, the present bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Prince Verma @ Prince Kumar Verma** is hereby **rejected with liberty to renew his prayer for bail after completion of charge-sheet.**
