Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 929/2026

ORDER

05.05.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Ranjeet Gupta, (2) Kisan Gupta, (3) Amit Gupta, (4) Rajan Gupta, (5) Rajesh Gupta, (6) Manish Gupta**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Guthani P.S. Case No. 70/2024 registered u/s 341, 323, 324, 379, 504/34 of IPC.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that during course of investigation, police found the case true only u/s 341, 323, 325/34 of IPC, thereafter the court was pleased to take the cognizance u/s 307 of IPC. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Guthani P.S Case No. 70/2024 was registered on 29.03.2024 u/s 341, 323, 324, 379, 506/34 of IPC against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 26.03.2024, her co-villagers petitioners along with other co-accused persons attacked her family members. It is alleged that Ranjit Gupta and Ramsagar Gupta attacked the son of informant Nilesh Gupta with Farsa and when the son of informant Jitendra came to her rescue, Rajan Gupta and Amit Gupta assaulted on his head with iron rod. It is further alleged that Rajesh Gupta and Manish Gupta dragged the informant catching her hair.

6. From perusal of injury report of injured, it appears that injured sustained following injuries:-

Shiv Mangal Gupta sustained injury:-

(i) Tenderness over left forearm

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(ii) Tenderness over the occipital area of the head

Nilesh Kumar Gupta sustained injuries:-

(i) Lacerated wound over the front of the forehead 3cm x 1cm

(ii) Tenderness over the left side of wrist

(iii) Tenderness over the occipital area

(iv) Tenderness over the left side of the shoulder and after x-ray of skull showing hairline fracture of the frontal bone of skull and doctor opined the nature of injury is grievous.

Jitendra Kumar Gupta sustained injuries:-

(i) Abrasion over the front of the forehead 1/2cm x 1/2cm

(ii) Tenderness over the occipital area

(iii) Tenderness over the left shoulder.

Thus, from perusal of injury report of injured, it appears that two persons sustained injury on their head, which is vital part of the body and the injury is intendant with the allegation. Charge-sheet has already been submitted.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail application filed on behalf of petitioners is hereby **rejected**.
