ORDER

24.04.2026

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners namely **(1) Rajan Sah, (2) Lalbabu Sah, (3) Deepak Kumar, (4) Pradeep Sah**, who are in judicial custody since 02.04.2026 in connection with Barharia P.S Case No. 147/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 324(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel further submits that both the parties have compromised the case. Petitioners are in judicial custody since 02.04.2026. There is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Barharia P.S Case No. 147/2026 was registered on 02.04.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 324(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners along with other co-accused persons. As per fardbeyan, the informant alleged that on 31.03.2026 at about 20:30 o'clock, he and his brother Ali Sher Ali were coming to his house Balapur on E-Rickshaw and when they reached near the house of Shambhu Sah, the petitioners along with other co-accused persons and 04-05 unknown persons started assaulting the informant and his brother with lathi-danda and damaged the E-rickshaw. It is alleged that Nandlal Sah, Surya Sah @ Sandeep, Dhiraj Sah assaulted on the mouth and head of the informant's brother. It is further alleged that Dhiraj Sah also assaulted on the head of informant's brother.

6. From perusal of bail petition, it appears that a compromise petition is available with bail petition and from perusal of which, it appears that good

sense has prevailed between the parties. During hearing of the bail petition, informant appeared before the court and supported the factum of compromise. Moreover, petitioners are in judicial custody since 02.04.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioners are directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below.
