ORDER

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **(1) Ritesh Gond**, who is in judicial custody since 31.03.2026 in connection with Ander P.S Case No. 109/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. Counsel further submits that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. There is counter case too. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 31.03.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Ander P.S Case No. 109/2026 was registered on 20.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 74, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 19.03.2026 at about 07:30 P.M (night), the petitioner along with other co-accused persons came at her house and started hurling abuses and assaulted with fist and slaps and knife. It is alleged that Raj Kumar and Guddu tore the informant's cloth and started assaulting. When, informant's dewar came for their rescue, Guddu and Jitendra gave knife blow on his neck. Guddu assaulted on the head of informant with knife and Golu assaulted on the head of informant's sasur with knife.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. From perusal of injury report of injured, it

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appears that they sustained simple injury. Moreover, petitioner is in custody since 31.03.2026.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-25 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and custody period of the petitioner, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below.
