**ORDER**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves present bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Dhiraj Kumar Yadav**, who is in judicial custody since 23.03.2026 in connection with Daraunda P.S. Case No. 365/2025 registered u/s 25(1-B)(a),26,35 of Arms Act.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner has got clean past. The prosecution story is totally false, concocted and baseless. Ld. counsel further submits that nothing incriminating article has been recovered either from the person or possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.03.2026. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.
3. On the other hand, Ld P.P vehemently opposes the prayer of bail.
4. Heard. Perused the record.
5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Daraunda P.S. Case No. 365/2025 was registered on 22.07.2025 u/s 25(1-B)(a),26,35 of Arms Act against the petitioner along with others. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that on 22.07.2025 at about 11:00 O'clock, he arrived for patrolling duty with other police personnel. At about 1:45 O'clock, he got secret information that three boys were roaming with arms on a motorcycle for committing crime and on this information, informant reached on spot and three boys started fleeing to see the police, but two were trapped by police and disclosed their name as Sandeep Yadav and Sanjay Yadav and also disclosed the name of fleeing person as Dhiraj Yadav and on search, one country made pistol from the left side of waist of Sandeep Yadav was recovered and from the pocket of Sanjay

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Yadav one live cartridge was recovered.

6. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent, but from perusal of para-31 of the case diary, it appears that petitioner bears two criminal antecedents, thus the petitioner has actively concealed his two criminal antecedents.
7. Considering the aforesaid facts & active concealment of two criminal antecedents, the present bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Dhiraj Kumar Yadav**, is hereby **rejected**.
