ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner moves present bail application filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **Santosh Pashi**, who is in judicial custody since 11.04.2026 in connection with Hussainganj P.S. Case No. 41/2025 registered u/s 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 117(2), 127(2), 109, 303(2) of BNS against petitioner and other co-accused persons.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case with an ulterior motive. Learned counsel further submits that no bail petition on behalf of the petitioner in the aforesaid case has ever been filed either before this learned Court or before the Hon'ble High Court at Patna. The petitioner has got clean past. The petitioner is rotting in the judicial custody since 11.04.2026. There is no chance of his absconding of tampering with the prosecution evidence. Thus, learned counsel prays that petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

3. On the other hand, learned P.P vehemently opposed the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R in this case was registered *vide* Hussainganj P.S Case No. 41/2025 dated 09.02.2025 u/s 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 117(2), 127(2), 109, 303(2) of BNS against other co-accused persons. As per F.I.R, the informant alleged that on 09.02.2025 at about 7:00 A.M, he along with Jigar was going to purchase items of his shop on his motorcycle. As soon as, the informant reached on Khairanti More, accused persons named in the FIR and some unknown women surrounded them and kidnap him and lock him in the house of accused Satish Yadav with intention to kill him. However, the informant's friend somehow managed to escape. It is further alleged that accused-persons brutally assaulted the informant, breaking his leg and leaving him

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unconscious. It is further alleged that Ranjan Yadav took out Rs. 25,000/- from his pocket and Amit Yadav took out his mobile Phone.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is no specific allegation against the petitioners. From perusal of supplementary injury report of Sazid Ali, it appears that he sustained grievous injuries at his leg and nose, whereas Jigar Ahmad sustained simple injury. From perusal of para No. 57 of case diary as well para No. 3 of bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears clean criminal antecedents. Earlier, similarly situated other co-accused persons granted bail by this Court vide order dated 22.04.2025, 28.03.2025, 27.02.2025 in A.B.P No. 761/2025, A.B.P No. 688/2025, B.P No. 191/2025 respectively. Moreover, petitioner is in judicial custody since 11.04.2026.

7. Considering the aforesaid and also the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 11.04.2026, the present bail application is **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court below.
