This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner **Ankush Aggarwal** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Daraunda P.S. Case No. 116/2026** registered u/s 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) of BNS. Heard both the side on bail petition.

The Id. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that no other bail application except this is pending before any other court and it is further submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case at the instance of ulterior motive. The Id. Counsel has further submitted that the petitioner has clean past and all the allegations made against the petitioner are totally false, baseless and concocted and no offence u/s 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) is made out against the petitioner. It is further stated that there is no chance of absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence and he is ready to furnish the bail bonds. Accordingly, the Id. Counsel has prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

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On the other hand, the Ld. APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail and has submitted that there is sufficient material available in the case diary to support the allegations against the petitioner. Accordingly, it has been prayed that the bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner may be rejected.

Heard both the side and perused the case record. From perusal of case record, it appears that in this case the F.I.R. has been lodged in connection with **Daraunda P.S. Case No. 116/2026** registered u/s 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) of BNS. The prosecution story in brief as per F.I.R. is that informant is working as PWS, Daraunda Godown as authorized manager and all the documents and letters are issued by him and he got information that HTC contractor Ankush Aggarwal alongwith other official and employees of the FCI Regional Office, Hajipur, forged his signatures, manipulated the records, and without his information and consent the said Ankush Aggarwal encashed many bills and he also used to supply food grains in lower quantity and he alongwith other officials of FCI manipulated the data. Despite repeated complaints through phone, whatsapp and email no action was taken and the forged signatures were allegedly used to pass fraudulent bills. The informant further states that Ankush Aggarwal has a history of embezzlement and fraud, has previously faced multiple FIR, and blacklisted by FCI.

From perusal of case record it appears that the accused petitioner is named accused of FIR. From perusal of para 2, 5 and 6 of case diary it appears that the informant as well as other witnesses have fully supported the prosecution case. It further appears that there is direct and specific allegation against the accused petitioner to misappropriate and cheating of the food

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grains and documents and bills of FCI. It further appears that the matter is still under investigation.

Therefore, considering the aforesaid facts and in keeping of view of the gravity and seriousness of offence, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the accused petitioner **Ankush Aggarwal** is hereby **rejected**.
