ORDER

29.04.2026

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners namely **(1) Vijay Prakash Pandey, (2) Uttam Prakash Pandey, (3) Ravi Prakash Pandey**, who are in judicial custody since 21.04.2026 in connection with Mairwa P.S Case No. 186/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 109, 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. Ld. Counsel further submits that both the parties are pattidar. There is counter case too. Both the parties have compromised the case. Petitioners are in judicial custody since 21.04.2026. There is no chance of their absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Mairwa P.S Case No. 186/2026 was registered on 19.04.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 109, 3(5) of BNS against the petitioners. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 19.04.2026, he was sitting at his shop. In the meantime, petitioners along with co-accused Shiv Sharan Pandey came on the shop informant armed with lathi and danda and told that you are provoking his host and assaulted the informant, his brother and nephew.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. During hearing of the bail, informant appeared before the court and stated that good sense has prevailed between the parties. Moreover, petitioner is in judicial custody since 21.04.2026.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and the fact that there is omnibus allegation against the petitioners, the present bail application is **allowed**, the
