Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 1175/2026

ORDER

29.05.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioners namely **(1) Samir Ansari, (2) Nasir Ansari @ Nazir Ali, (3) Faiyaz Ansari @ Faiyaz Hussain, (4) Harun Rashid, (5) Masoom Bhat @ Masook Ali, (6) Aarif Ansari @ Aarif Hussain**, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Hussainganj P.S. Case No. 138/2026 registered u/s 189(2), 126(2), 115(2), 110, 35, 351(2) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence, rather they have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners bear no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. There is counter case too. There is no chance of their absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R vide Hussainganj P.S. Case No. 138/2026 was registered on 24.03.2026 u/s 189(2), 126(2), 115(2), 110, 35, 351(2) of BNS against the petitioners. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 24.03.2026 at about 07:00 P.M, he was taking break fast on his Darwaja. In the meantime, due to previous dispute, all the petitioners came at the Darwaja of the informant and started assaulting the informant with fist and slaps, lathi-danda. When, the younger brother of the informant Banti Kumar came to his rescue, all the petitioners assaulted him.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is omnibus allegation against the petitioners. From perusal of injury reports of informant and his brother, it appears that they sustained simple injury.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-41 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioners bear no criminal antecedent.

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8. Considering the aforesaid facts and the fact that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**.

9. It is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing by them bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
