Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 898/2026

G.B Nagar P.S. Case No. 538/2025

ORDER

06.05.2026

1. Ld. Counsel moves this anticipatory bail petition on behalf of accused petitioner namely **(1) Seraj Ali**, who apprehends his arrest in connection with G.B Nagar P.S. Case No. 538/2025 registered u/s 137(2), 87 of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. The allegations as narrated in the FIR is totally false, baseless and concocted. Ld. counsel further submits that the victim girl is major and she willfully married with this petitioner without fear and pressure and on 26.03.2026, the victim girl came before the court and given her statement u/s 183 of BNSS and not supported the allegation of elopement. There is no chance of his absconding and tampering with the evidence. Hence, Ld. Counsel prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an F.I.R *vide* G.B Nagar P.S. Case No. 538/2025 was registered on 26.11.2025 u/s 137(2), 87 of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 24.11.2025 at about 5:00 P.M, she was working in her field and no one present at her house, when her daughter Putul Kumari went anywhere from her house. When the informant started searching Putul Kumari, she got knowledge that Seraj Ali and Aftab Ali had kidnapped her. It is further alleged that Seraj Ali had eloped the daughter of the informant with intention to marry with her. It is further alleged that Kuraishi Khatoon, Imteyaz Ali were also involved in eloping the informant's daughter.

6. From perusal of FIR, it appears that there is allegation against the petitioner that he kidnapped the informant's daughter. From perusal of L.C.R, it appears that the victim is major and during her statement u/s 183 of BNSS before

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the court below, she had not supported the allegation of kidnapping and stated that she solemnized marriage with the petitioner on her own will.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition as well as para-38 of the case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts, the present anticipatory bail petition is **allowed.**

9. It is directed that in the event of his arrest or surrender before learned trial court within six weeks, the petitioner shall be released on furnishing by him bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court subject to conditions as mentioned under section 482 of BNSS.
