ORDER

1. The present bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner namely **(1) Ajay Manjhi**, who is in judicial custody since 13.04.2026 in connection with Maharajganj P.S Case No. 81/2026 registered u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS.

2. Ld. Counsel of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence, rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner bears one criminal antecedent. The prosecution story is totally false, baseless and concocted. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 13.04.2026. There is no chance of his absconding or tampering with the prosecution evidence. Hence, learned counsel prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. P.P opposes the prayer of bail.

4. Heard. Perused the record.

5. From perusal of the record, it transpires that an FIR vide Maharajganj P.S Case No. 81/2026 was registered on 06.03.2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of BNS against the petitioner along with other co-accused persons. As per FIR, the informant alleged that on 06.03.2026 at about 10:00 A.M, she was coming to her house from the field of her mustard crop. In the meantime, all the accused persons assaulted the informant and her daughter Manisha Kumari with Sabal, lathi. It is alleged that the petitioner tore the blouse and saree of the informant.

6. From perusal of record, it appears that there is allegation against the petitioner that he tore the blouse and saree of the informant except this there is no allegation attributed against the petitioner.

7. As per para-3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner bears one criminal antecedent of Excise Act and from perusal of para-25 of the photo copy of case diary, it appears that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent. Moreover, petitioner is in jail custody since 13.04.2026.

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8. Considering the aforesaid facts and custody period of the petitioner, the present bail application is **allowed**, the petitioner is directed to be released immediately on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below **with condition that the petitioner shall not repeat such offence in future. If the petitioner is subsequently found indulged in similar offences, the learned trial Court shall take steps for cancellation of his bail bond.**
